That is about all the heads up I have so let me know where you are catching fish so I can get one.

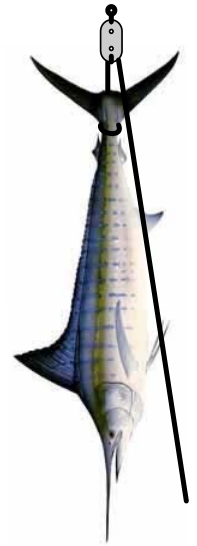

A castoff from the Rachel, Dan Claypool jumped aboard and brought in a 20.1 YFT to give *Scott's Johnny* a 2nd Place Boat finish.
